Carl Wells Sr., 80, husband of Virginia Prewitt Wells, passed away Sunday, January 20, 2013, at his home. He was born May 25, 1932 in Perry County, Kentucky, the son of the late William H. and Scythia Drake Wells. On March 29, 1952, he married Virginia Dare Prewitt in Hazard, Kentucky and from that union had two sons, Paul Wayne Wells and Carl Wells, Jr. In January of 1956, he received his Funeral Director's License from the Kentucky Board of Embalmers and Funeral Directors and in May of 1961 he graduated from Kentucky School of Embalming. He truly loved his community and dedicated his life to serving the needs of his fellow Powell Countians through the Wells Funeral Home and Wells Ambulance Service. He also served as Powell County Coroner for forty four years. He was a member and deacon of Stanton Christian Church, longtime member of Stanton and Clay City Lions Clubs, member and Past Master of Stanton Masonic Lodge F&AM 352, member of the Oleika Shrine Temple of Lexington and a former member of the Order of Eastern Star. He was a charter member of both the Powell County Flying Club and Beechfork Golf Club and was a former Boy Scout Leader of Troop #351. He also served on the Powell County Board of Directors of Whitaker Bank.
