*I retired from the army in 1990 as a CW3..Dsrell andshared the same goofy sense of humor and he was a fabulous pilot...*

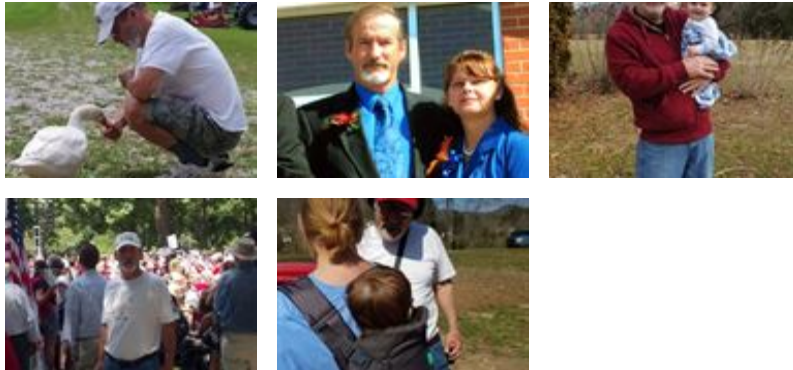
