February 12, 1945 - March 1, 2015

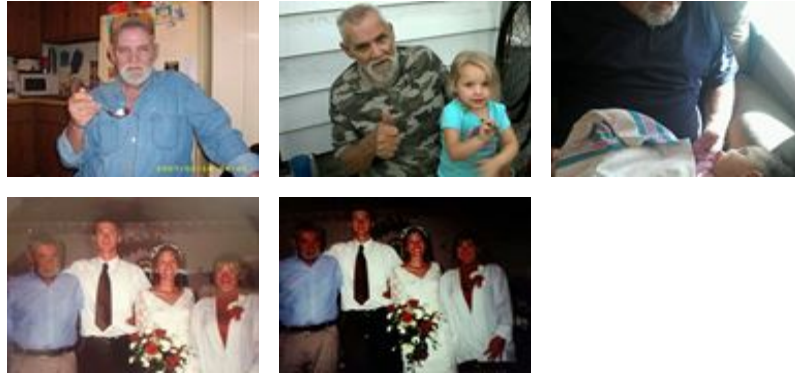
