Felcia Rogers McIntyre, 97, of Stanton, Ky passed away peacefully on May 31, 2019 at the Greg and Noreen Wells Hospice Center, Hazard, Kentucky. She was born in Powell County, Ky on January 15 1922 to the late Henry and Nell Spencer Rogers. She married Alex McIntyre Jr on December 14, 1941 at First Presbyterian Church, Hazard. Early years of their marriage, like so many of their generation were spent with her waiting for his return from his service to his country in World War II, where he was wounded in Germany and hospitalized in England for an extended time. Upon his return they returned to Hazard to begin life there that led to the births of 6 children, and a life of community involvement, entrepreneurial endeavors, and always dedication to God and their church. Felcia was an active member of 1st Presbyterian church in Hazard, many civic organizations, and everything to do with schools and the education of children. She was an inspiration to all and her love for God, family, and community was reflected throughout her life. She was voted Mother of the Year for Kentucky and was recognized by Governor Martha Layne Collins. She was an artist and loved cooking, gardening and floral design and arranging. She loved working with the youth at Dessie Scott Children's Home in Campton, KY. She was a devoted wife, mother, and grandmother. She was a strong, kind, loving, caring person who was always there to help wherever there was a need. She loved her family and friends and praised God for all the blessings he bestowed upon her life. She is preceded by her husband, Alex, her son, John Kevin, her grandson, Kelly

Patrick Moore, and two sisters: Winona Rogers Duckworth, and Golden Rogers Shook. She is survived by her children: Alois Ann McIntyre Moore (Bill), Dr. Deborah Louise McIntyre Roark (Jim), Dr. Alex Brian McIntyre (Glinda), Dan Colin McIntyre (Carolyn), James Keith McIntyre (Kim). 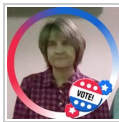
