Pete was the first one to the hospital when we learned my dad wasn't going to make it. He drove me to the funeral home to make the arrangements. He was by my family's side the whole way, because he was family. My dad was tough on Pete like he was his own children, he took up for him like he was his brother, and he loved him like the best friend he was. After dad's passing Pete had a hard time coming around. He told us that sometimes he caught himself driving by the house only to remember dad wasn't home. Overtime, we all lost contact with Pete. Since becoming a mother I've often thought I need to visit Pete, I need to see what he thinks my dad would think of my daughter. Unfortunately, I didn't make the time to do that. My heart breaks knowing I can't visit him now. Pete, you are forever in my heart. Rest in peace.
