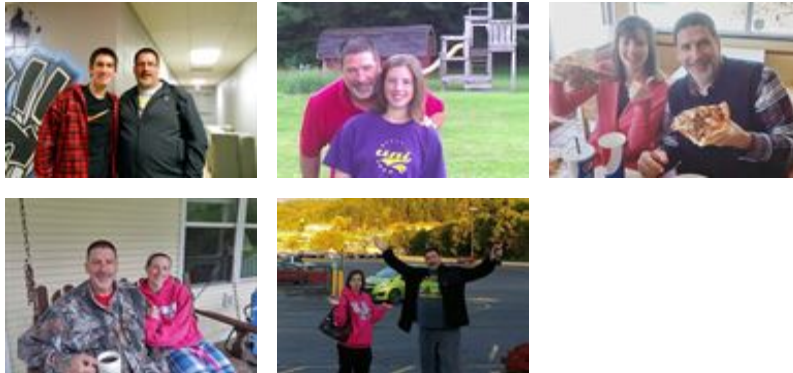
Pastor Pete was so friendly and joyful. He just exuberated this happy, joyful spirit. It was always a pleasure to be around him and his family.
