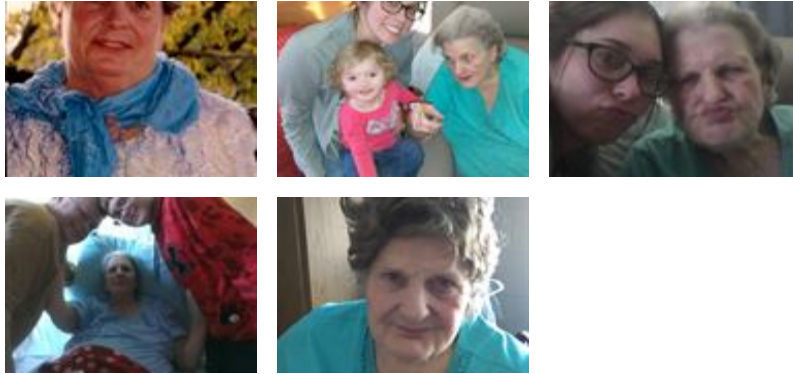
May 19, 1935 - April 24, 2016
