Ricky Thomas Hall, 68, of Stanton, passed away Saturday, March 12, 2016 in Stanton, Kentucky.

Rick was born on January 24, 1948 in Martin, Kentucky, the son of the late Adrian and Olive Rose Turner Hall. He grew up in Floyd County, and was a graduate of McDowell High School. At McDowell, Rick earned all-state honors as a basketball player in 1966 and was awarded an athletic scholarship to Marshall University where he was a member of the basketball team from 1966 to 1970. Following his graduation, Rick began teaching and coaching, first at Russell Independent schools, then at McDowell High School and later at Powell County High School. At Powell County, he taught English, coached both Boys and Girls Basketball and eventually retired as the school's Athletic Director. Following his retirement, Rick loved to spend time with his daughters and their families in Seminole and Largo, Florida, where he owned a second home. He was of the Baptist Faith.
