“ Steve and I crossed paths in February 1974 in the 14th Region semi-finals at Breathitt Coliseum, Jackson. I was a starting guard on the Breathitt High School squad that was defeated by Powell High School and Powell High School went on to the KHSAA State Tournament in Louisville. Steve was the starting forward or guard on the Powell team and Steve was a superior shooter. James "Goose" Goodwin, Jay Means, Mark Orme and others were members of that squad as many of you remember. Little did I know that game would last as a lifetime memory, pleasant and disappointing memories. Pleasant because I competed and disappointing because we got defeated.

Thirty years later, Steve and I would cross-paths often at Kathy's Restaurant at Clay City and we would kid each other about this game. In the final seconds with the game tied or Breathitt High School ahead by one point, I fouled Steve with a few seconds remaining on the clock and sent Steve to the line. As many remember, Steve hit both free throws and sent Powell High School to the State Tournament for the first time. Powell easily defeated MC Napier in the finals. Steve always said: "Frank, you made me famous."

Steve was a part of my teenager years and his passing has brought back many emotions and memories of Steve and all those guys. I attended basketball camp at Morehead State University one summer when Powell High School was in attendance. When those guys hit the floor, they were one and tough nosed. Mischievous as they come as well.

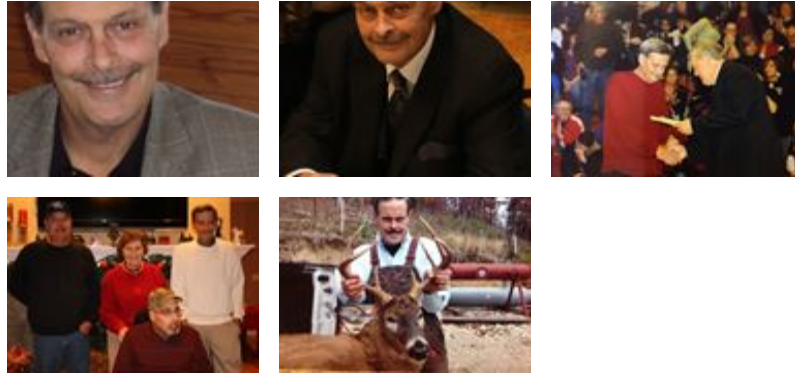
