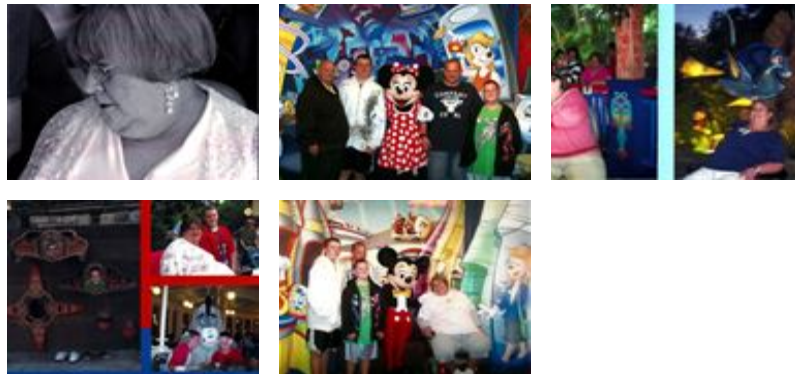

*I've had such a heavy heart since learning of Wendy's passing. Growing up in Powell County in a bubble with nearly all white faces, nearly all Christian, I was lucky enough to have befriended Ruthie and got to know her Jewish family. Her house was so different from most of my friends. It was loud and funny, their home impeccably decorated. They spoke differently, and I having spent my first 10 years in Ohio, did too and I was comforted to find other "aliens". I'm so thankful for my time spent in their home.*

*Wendy taught me that you can be loud and blunt and also kind and loving. She taught me that in a flock of flamingo it's okay to be a penguin. Own it. Flaunt it. Be who you are.*

*Wendy was the childcare provider for my big kids. I never made it home on schedule because she and I would get lost in conversation. She never held back when giving me good advice. Even if it stung, it was a gift. She was still shaping who I am. She only was able to meet my youngest child a couple of times but through Facebook she was able to be Granny Wendy to her as well. I loved having a way to stay connected to her. She loved every photo and video I posted and was able to send things to her inbox as well.*

*Wendy was a champion for the Powell County High School band. I've never before and perhaps never will again see anything like it. Without her own kids or grandkids involved she continued to fund raise and attend performances for years. She was the biggest cheerleader they ever had.*

*I'll never see a penguin or a marching band and not think of her. Her personality took up a lot of space. We are going to feel this loss deeply, but she would want us to laugh and share and make a party.*
