Willie Eugene Profitt, 83, widower of Geneva Creech Profitt, passed away Tuesday, May 26 at his home. He was born April 21, 1932 in Slade, Kentucky to the late William M. and Elizabeth Brewer Profitt. He was an Corporal in Third Infiltiry Division in the Korean War conflict. Following his service in the Army he was employed at the Lexington Bluegrass Army Depot in the calibration lab, retiring after 40 years. He was a member of the Clay City Lion's Club since 1975, currently serving as their president. A dedicated Wildcat fan however his heart belonged to the Powell County Pirates. If you ever played sports in Powell County you could always count on seeing Willie Profitt in the stands supporting the team. He was an avid fisherman, carpenter, and all around handy man to anyone who needed a helping hand. He was a member of the Stanton Baptist Church. 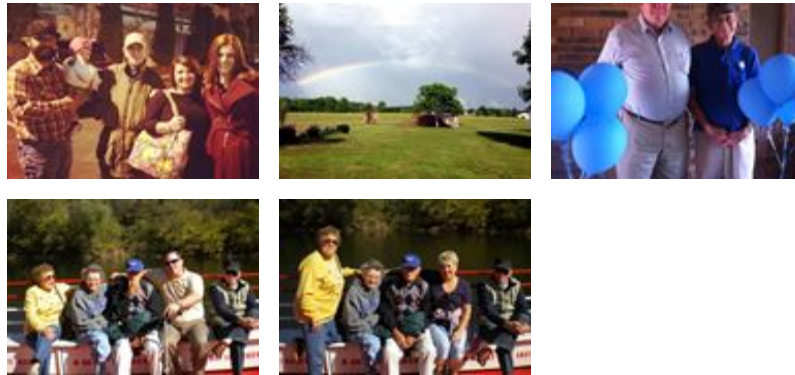

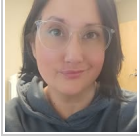

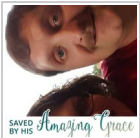
